TUBE THE RIVER

Tube year-round from Midpoint or Dampier's Landing at the South Entrance. Rentals and transportation available at the General Store.



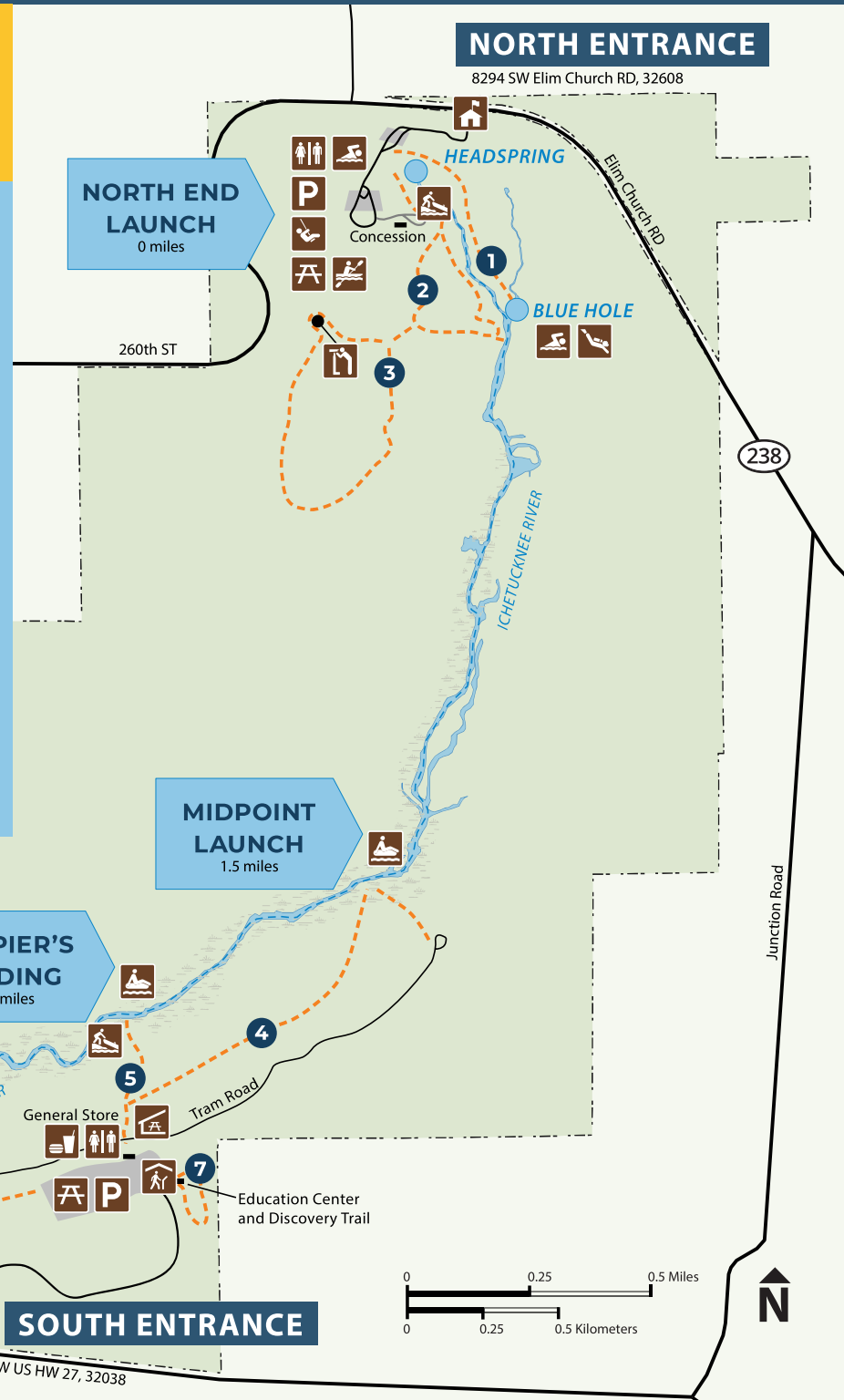
CANOE AND KAYAK
